## CHANGE TO ACTIVATED PROTEIN-C RESISTANCE REFERENCE INTERVALS

Effective March 27, 2024 our special coagulation lab will be switching to a new lot of reagent for Activated Protein-C Resistance (APCR) test. The change in reagent will result in a new cut value to indicate an abnormal APCR result. A summary of the new reference interval can be seen below.

### APCR REFERENCE INTERVAL CHANGES

	Current	Effective March 27
Abnormality – Abnormal	$\leq 2.13$	$\leq 2.23$
Reference Range	$> 2.13$	$> 2.23$
